The 2024 UMBC Battleground Exit Poll gauges the attitudes of Baltimore County voters on the following topics:

- Presidential, U.S. Senate, and congressional vote choices and key issues determining their decisions
- Question 1 and attitudes toward abortion
- Economic perceptions
- Trust in government
- Opinions toward the Democratic Party, Republican Party, Supreme Court of the United States, and the mainstream news media
- Types of news sources used by voters

Exit poll toplines and results by demographics will be provided.

About the UMBC Battleground Exit Poll

The UMBC Battleground Exit Poll surveyed 1,119 Baltimore County voters on October 31, 2024, during early voting from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. and on Election Day, November 5, 2024, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Contact locations were determined by random selection. During the early voting period, responses were collected at four early voting sites, and on Election Day, responses were collected at 13 precincts across the county. Results were weighted to countywide vote totals for the presidential and senate elections.

The UMBC Institute of Politics is committed to transparency. The release will include a methodology statement with information regarding data collection, sample demographics, weighting, and question-wording.
