#### **About the UMBC Poll**

The UMBC Poll surveyed **803** Maryland adults from Tuesday, February 11, to Saturday, February 15, 2025. Of the **803** Maryland adults surveyed (MOE=+/- **3.5%**), **769** indicated they were registered voters (MOE=+/**3.5%**). As part of the UMBC Poll's commitment to transparency, the release will include a methodology statement that includes information regarding data collection, sample demographics, weighting, and question wording.
